

PSP5 – SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

We are seeking for sponsorship for **PSP5, Phosphorus in Soils and Plants**, Fifth International Symposium, to be held from 26 to 29 August 2014 at Le Corum, Convention Center of Montpellier in France and expected to host 200-250 participants from worldwide.

PSP5, Phosphorus in Soils and Plants is hosted and sponsored by CIRAD, INRA, IRD, LabEx AGRO (Agropolis Fondation) and Montpellier SupAgro, with support from CEA and CNRS. Dr Philippe Hinsinger (Directeur de Recherche at INRA Montpellier, UMR Eco&Sols) is the Local Chair of this symposium. PSP5 is the fifth international symposium of a successful series on Phosphorus Dynamics in the Soil-Plant Continuum that was launched in Beijing (China) in 2000. It is thus the first time it occurs in Europe, but being located in Montpellier in the very South of France, i.e. in the Mediterranean basin, it shall facilitate the participation of African scientists, and scientists from developing countries at large, where ***Facing Phosphorus Scarcity*** is a major issue.

PSP5 will be a multidisciplinary event, bringing together plant nutritionists (plant physiology, genetics and systems biology), agronomists, ecologists, biogeochemists and soil scientists from worldwide, fostering scientific exchanges across discipline boundaries, in order to face the challenge of phosphorus limitations in many agroecosystems and terrestrial ecosystems. PSP5 will be immediately followed by the 4th Sustainable Phosphorus Summit to be held in Montpellier from 1st to 3rd September 2014, where global concerns about phosphorus sustainability will be discussed. You will thus have the opportunity to attend both events and be part of this unique **PHOSPHORUS week 2014**.

Exhibition Details

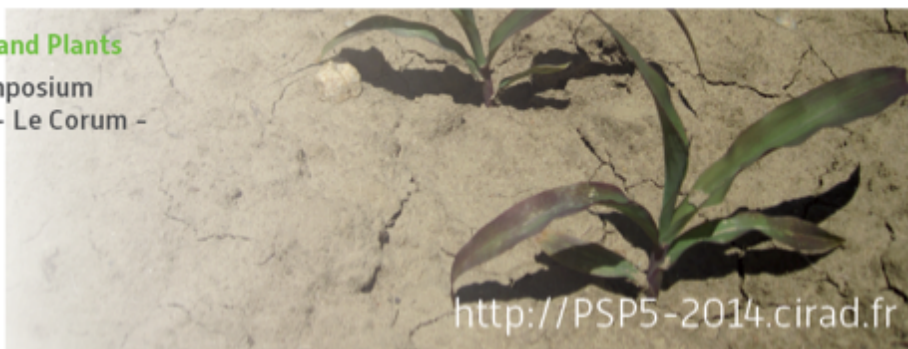
- The exhibition will be open from Tuesday morning 26th August 2014 and will resume on Friday 29th August 2014 after the morning coffee break.

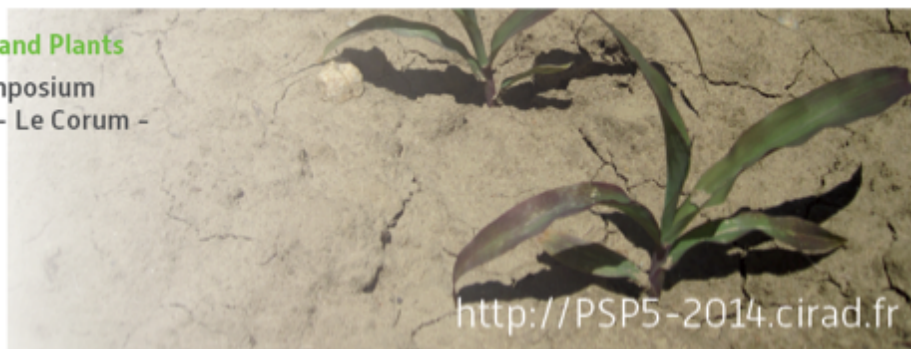
